

Review the following instructions for the installation of our Bar Linear Concealed Mud-In Frame (DABLJ/DABLDJ/DABLRJ/DABLDJ).

Instructions:

- 1. If the bar linear has a removable core (DABLRJ/DABLDRJ), remove the core from frame. If not, proceed directly to **Step 2**.
- 2. Clean and degrease the tapered border and flange to ensure no residue, debris or oil is on the surface.
- 3. Install the frame to drywall using the drywall screw provided.
- 4. Apply a bonding agent over the surface of the flange, and allow to dry per the manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Apply a coat of drywall compound onto grille flange and extend the compound 3" onto drywall.
- 6. Embed 4" wide mesh or paper tape into joint compound. Add a second layer of joint compound atop the tape and smooth.
- 7. Apply a minimum two coats of finishing compound, ensuring to finish over the inside edge of flange. Let each coat dry completely before sanding smooth.
- 8. Apply your paint or finish coat. Allow finish coat to dry completely.
- 9. If the bar linear has a removable core (DABLRJ/DABLDRJ), install the core back into the frame.
