

Commercial Form and General Legal Note

This Limited Warranty applies only to new louver products manufactured by Dayus Register & Grille Inc. ("Dayus") and sold by Dayus or an authorized Dayus distributor. It extends only to the original purchaser ("Buyer"), is non-transferable except with Dayus's written consent, and applies only after the applicable invoice has been paid in full.

This Limited Warranty is intended for commercial sales. Nothing in this Limited Warranty is intended to negate, vary, or exclude any condition, warranty, right, or remedy that cannot lawfully be excluded, restricted, or modified under applicable law.

Unless otherwise expressly stated in writing by Dayus, all warranty periods in this Limited Warranty run from the date of shipment from Dayus's facility.

Part 1. Louver Products Warranty

Dayus warrants that its louver products will be free from defects in material and workmanship, under normal use and service, for a period of five (5) years from the date of shipment.

If Buyer gives Dayus written notice of an alleged defect within thirty (30) days after discovery, or when Buyer ought reasonably to have discovered the defect, and in all events before the end of the applicable warranty period, and Dayus determines after inspection that the product is defective in material or workmanship, Dayus will, at its option, either repair the defective product, replace the defective product, or refund the portion of the purchase price allocable to the defective product.

These remedies are Buyer's sole and exclusive remedies under Part 1.

Part 1 does not cover:

- normal wear and tear;
- improper storage, handling, installation, use, application, or maintenance;
- abuse, misuse, accident, negligence, or unauthorized alteration or repair;
- corrosion or deterioration resulting from abnormal, highly corrosive, contaminated, or otherwise unsuitable environmental conditions;
- damage caused by fire, flood, wind, lightning, Acts of God, jobsite damage, excessive building movement, or other causes beyond Dayus's reasonable control;
- damage caused by work performed or materials supplied by others;
- products or components not manufactured by Dayus, except to the extent any third-party warranty is assignable or pass-through; and
- labor or field costs of any kind, including access, inspection openings, testing, removal, de-installation, re-installation, scaffolding, lifts, freight, or field finishing, unless Dayus expressly agrees otherwise in writing.

Any repaired or replacement product furnished under Part 1 will be warranted only for the unexpired balance of the original warranty period.

Part 2. Finish Warranty

Part 2 applies only to factory-applied finishes on Dayus louvers.

* Prime Coat coverage applies only against defects in factory application and only if the product receives a field-applied finish coat within 6 months after shipment.

Specialty Finishes

Unless Dayus expressly agrees otherwise in writing, any finish applied to steel or galvaneal substrates, and any metallic, custom, exotic, mica, clear-coat, or other specialty finish not specifically listed above, is warranted only as stated by Dayus in writing and, if no separate written term is stated, for one (1) year from shipment against defects in factory application only.

Performance Standard

Under normal atmospheric conditions and on cleaned and properly maintained surfaces, Dayus warrants that:

- AAMA 2605 and AAMA 2604 finishes will not peel, blister, chip, crack, or otherwise lose film integrity in a manner that materially affects appearance when viewed from 10 feet (3 metres), at 90 degrees to the surface, in natural daylight;
- AAMA 2605 and AAMA 2604 finishes will not chalk or fade beyond the limits of the applicable AAMA / ASTM performance standard for the specified coating system;
- anodized finishes will resist cracking, crazing, flaking, and blistering and will not change color by more than five (5) Delta E Hunter units when tested under applicable ASTM methods; and
- standard paints, powder coats, and primers are warranted only against defects in factory application and adhesion, and not against broader architectural weathering performance unless Dayus expressly states otherwise in writing.

Conditions and Exclusions for Part 2

Part 2 applies only if the finished product is properly stored, handled, installed, cleaned, and maintained in accordance with Dayus instructions and applicable AAMA care, cleaning, and maintenance guidance for architecturally finished aluminum.

Part 2 does not cover:

- normal weathering within the limits of the applicable finish standard;
- color, gloss, or weathering variation caused by unequal exposure to sun, weather, or environment;
- cutting, drilling, punching, welding, bending, forming, or other fabrication performed after finishing that damages or alters the finish;
- abrasion, scratching, impact damage, or other mechanical damage;
- field touch-up, repainting, or refinishing by others;
- damage caused by improper or harsh cleaners, incompatible sealants, gaskets, mastics, or adjacent materials;
- standing or ponding water;
- galvanic corrosion or contact with dissimilar metals;
- substrate corrosion, edge corrosion, or corrosion originating beneath the finish;
- corrosive fumes, ash, chemicals, foreign substances, or contaminated atmospheres;
- improper storage or packaging before installation; and
- installation within 1,000 feet of salt water or in other high-salt or marine environments, unless specifically approved in writing by Dayus and maintained under a documented cleaning program.

Dayus's sole liability under Part 2, and Buyer's exclusive remedy, is limited to Dayus's option to refinish the affected area, repair the affected product, replace the affected product, or refund the portion of the purchase price allocable to the defective finish. Dayus will not pay for labor, access equipment, freight, removal, re-installation, scaffolding, lifts, or other project costs. Any refinished, repaired, or replaced product will be warranted only for the unexpired balance of the original Finish Warranty period.

Part 3. Warranty Claim Procedure

All warranty claims must be submitted to Dayus in writing within thirty (30) days after discovery of the alleged defect, or when Buyer ought reasonably to have discovered the defect, and in all events before the end of the applicable warranty period and before any repair, removal, destructive testing, or refinishing is undertaken.

Each claim should include the project name and location, date of shipment, Dayus invoice or order number if available, product identification, description of the alleged defect, photographs, and any maintenance records reasonably requested by Dayus.

Dayus must be given a reasonable opportunity to inspect the product. Before any field or laboratory test is used to support a claim, Dayus must receive reasonable prior notice and a reasonable opportunity to observe the test or review the proposed test conditions. Dayus may require return of samples or product, freight prepaid, if reasonably necessary to evaluate the claim.

No employee, distributor, representative, purchase order, or other document may enlarge or modify this Limited Warranty unless Dayus agrees in writing signed by an authorized officer.

If any provision of this Limited Warranty is found unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in effect to the fullest extent permitted by law.

This Limited Warranty does not limit any rights that cannot lawfully be limited or excluded under applicable law.

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, DAYUS SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, INDIRECT, PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY, OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING LOSS OF PROFIT, LOSS OF USE, LOSS OF REVENUE, DELAY DAMAGES, OR CLAIMS OF THIRD PARTIES.
